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Jazz Ensemble students are assigned parts based on their ability. Although, all students are encouraged to improvise, the more advanced students are given the opportunity to perform solos in concerts and festivals. Music is chosen by the director with student input that allows the group to develop and focus on their strengths as well as address any weak areas.

Jazz Ensemble students rehearse two times per week for 40 minutes before school. Friday mornings are reserved for sectional rehearsals. Students are able to get more individualized instruction and address concerns in their music in a smaller setting. Students may also meet with the instructor individually when there is a need to do so.

Students also work with guest artists twice a year for our Fall and Spring Jazz Nights. Guest artists perform with the jazz groups and give workshops to our students.

We also attend 3-4 Jazz Festivals per year where students are assessed by a panel of judges.
